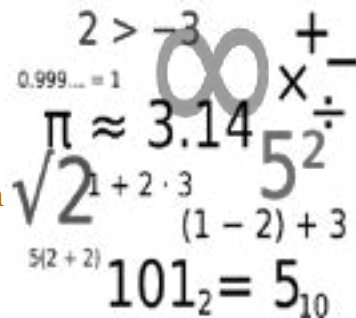

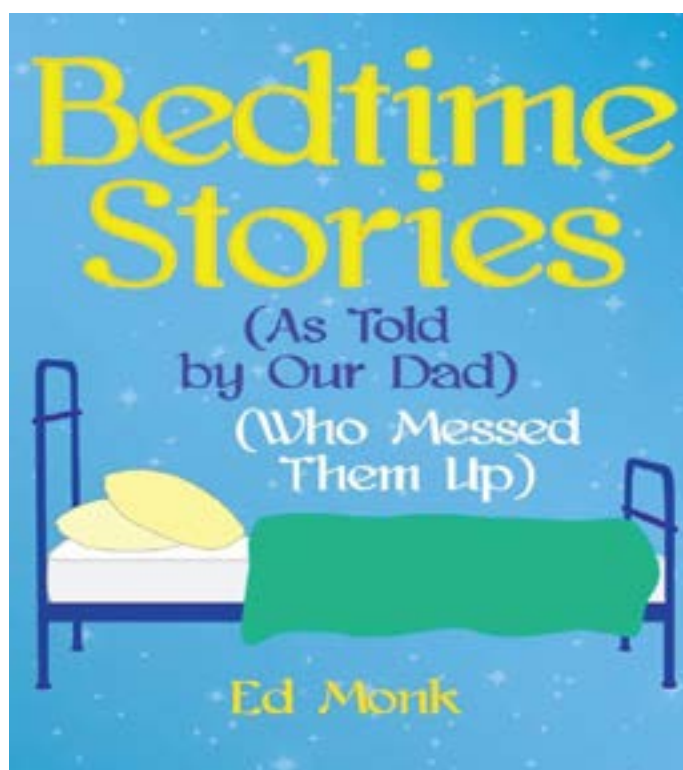
Upcoming Parent Coffee
